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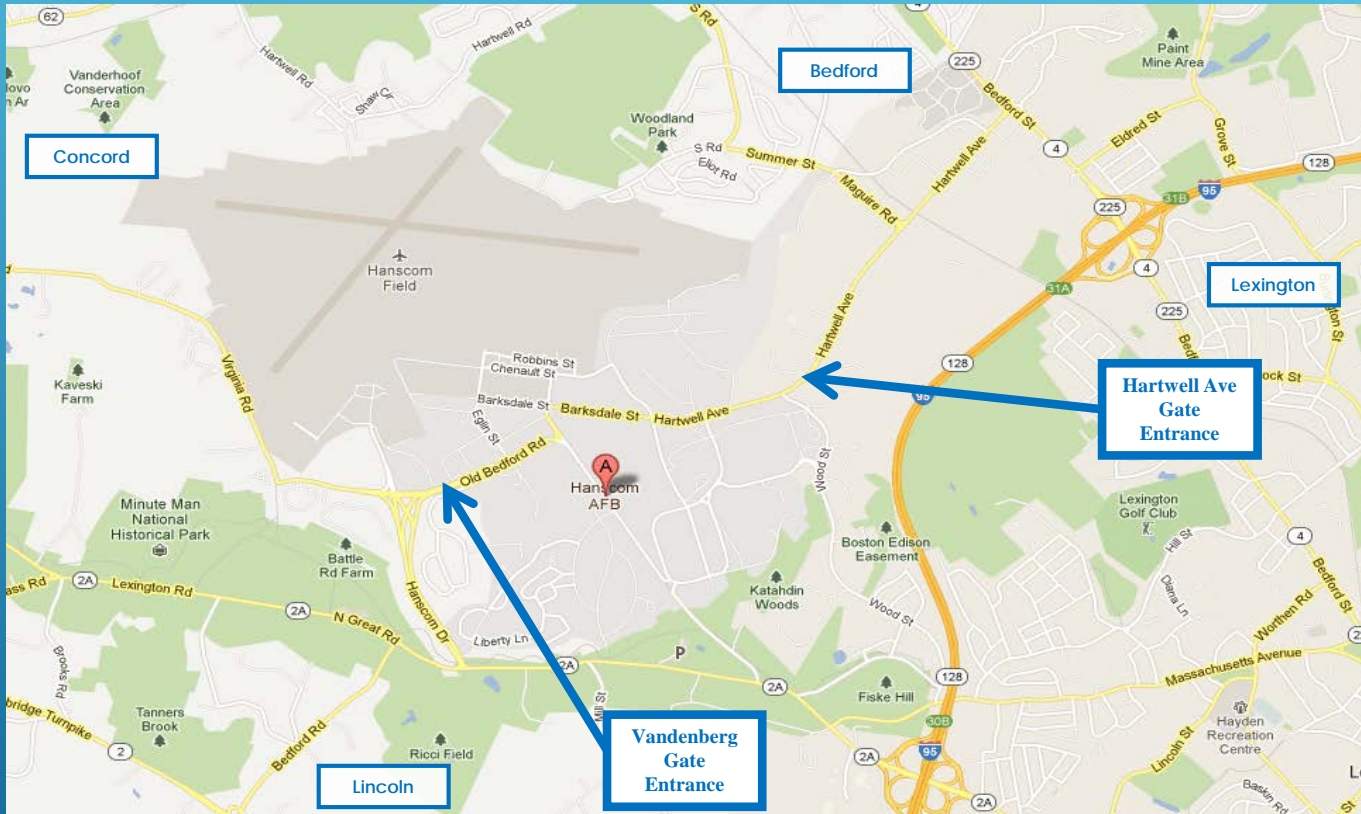
## DEC 2018 WORKSHOP: DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO HANSCOM AFB



- ▶ There are 2 entrances/gates to Hanscom AFB, and either will work for the ICEAA NE Cost Workshop
  - ▶ If you have a DoD ID card (i.e. CAC card) or retiree ID card, simply present it at either gate
  - ▶ If you DO NOT have a DoD ID card, your name will be on a guest list at BOTH gates (choose either gate). Simply present your driver license and tell the guard you are attending the ICEAA Cost Workshop
- ▶ **Directions to the Vandenberg Gate (Visitor Center located here; Open 6am to 6pm):**
  - ▶ Take Exit 30B off I-95/Rt 128 North, Hanscom Field Exit (Rte 2A west), go 1 1/2 miles to the blinking light, follow sign to Hanscom AFB (Hanscom drive) and take a right, go 1/4 mile straight, bear right to Hanscom AFB, Vandenberg Gate
  - ▶ Follow above instructions for base access. The Vandenberg Gate is open 5 a.m. to 10 p.m
- ▶ **Directions to the Hartwell Gate:**
  - ▶ Take Exit 31 B off I-95/Rte128 North. Exit to the right onto Rt4N, and follow to the jug handle turn located just past the Massachusetts Army National Guard building and Boston Sports Club on the right. Take the jug handle. This is Hartwell Ave. Follow Hartwell Ave. to the end, where you will reach the Hartwell Gate to Hanscom
  - ▶ Follow above instructions for base access
- ▶ **Directions to Hanscom From Logan International Airport (Boston):**
  - ▶ As you depart Logan Airport follow the signs to the Massachusetts Turnpike, I-90. I-90 will take you through the Ted Williams Tunnel (toll). Stay on I-90 until you reach I-95 / Rte 128. There will be additional tolls. Take I-95 North toward Peabody. From Rte I-95 proceed to Exit 30B (visitors/personnel with no DoD ID) or Exit 31B (with DoD ID cards). Logan Airport/Boston is approximately 20 miles from Hanscom
- ▶ **From Points South:**
  - ▶ Take I-95/128 North to either Exit 30B (visitors/personnel with no DoD ID) or Exit 31B (with DoD ID cards)

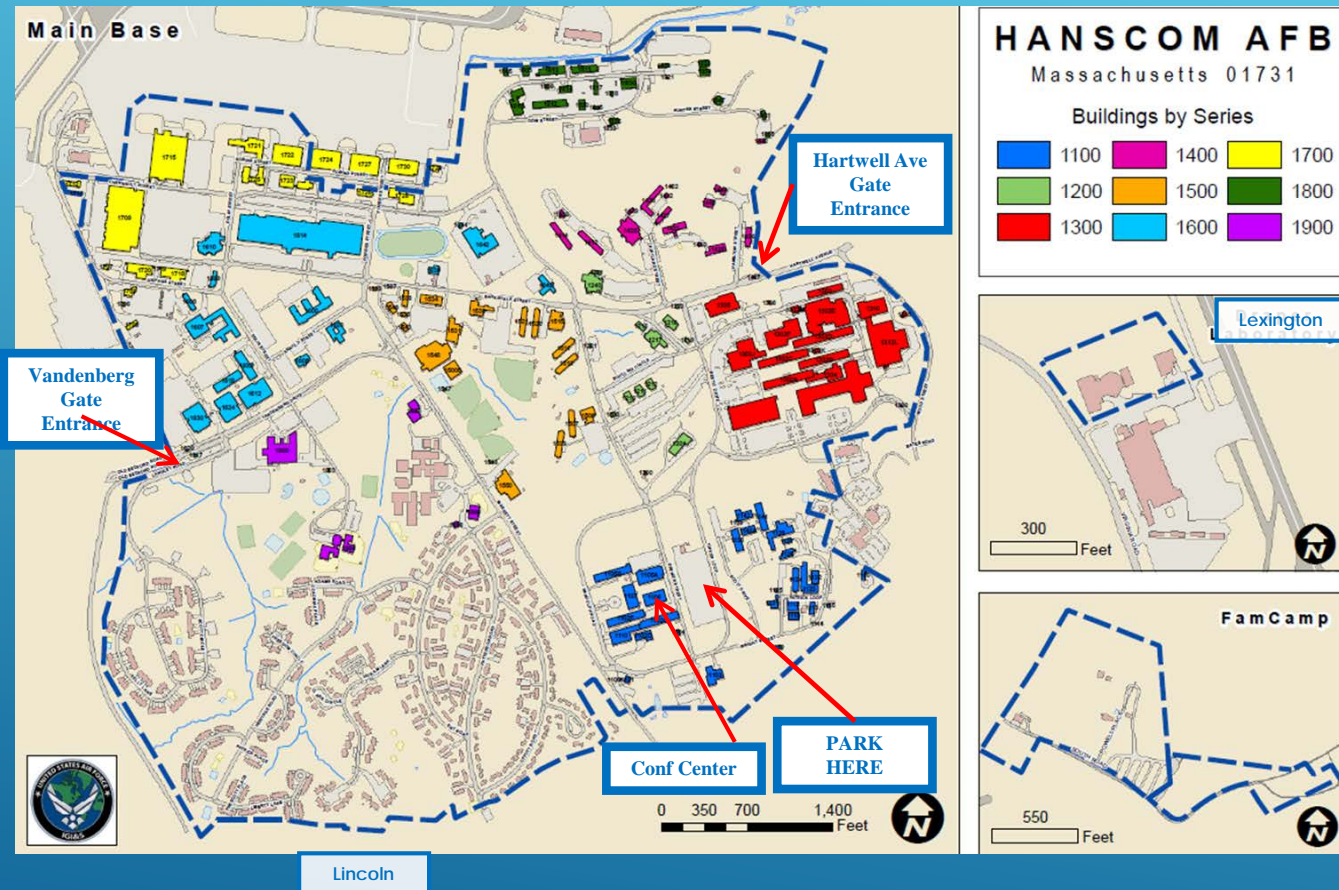
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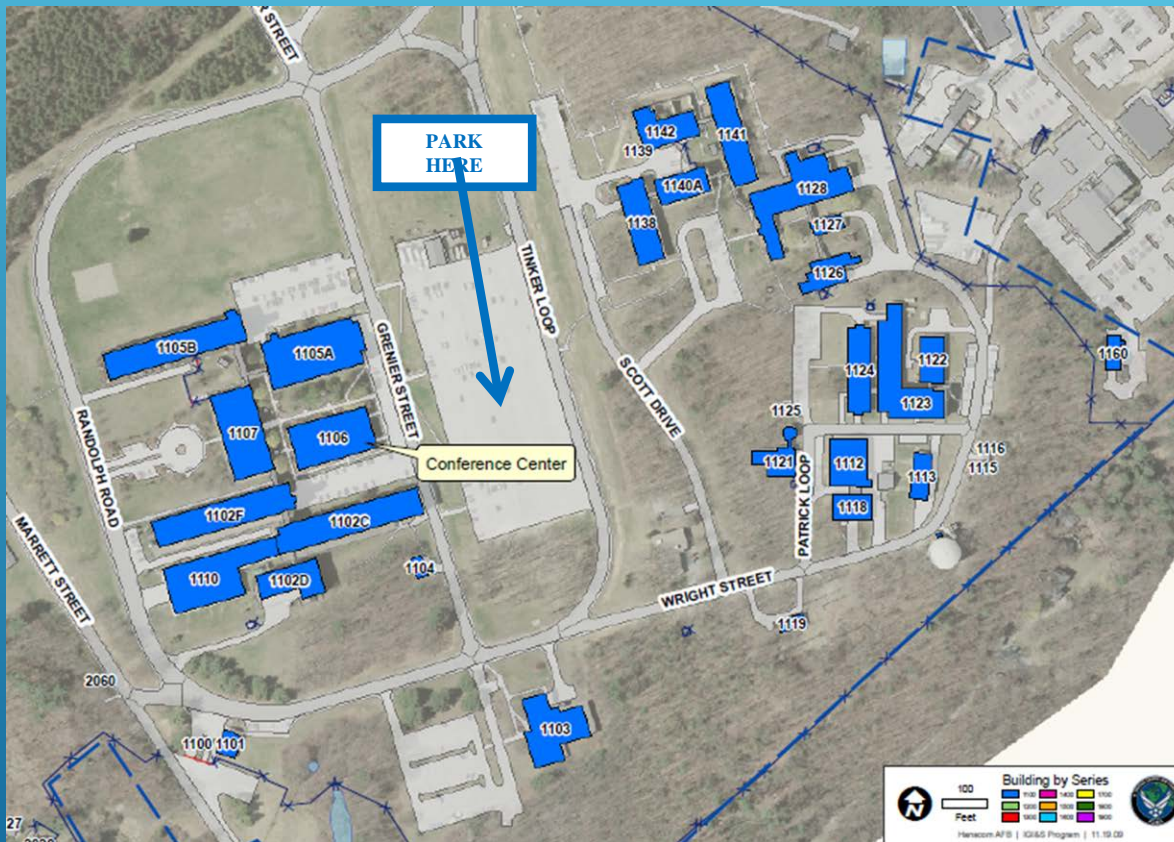

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## DEC 2018 WORKSHOP: HANSCOM AFB INFORMATION



### ▶ To avoid traffic tickets

- ▶ Carefully follow posted speed limits and other traffic signs
