Purpose of ICEAA

Purpose of the Association:

Advancing, encouraging, promoting and enhancing the profession of cost estimating and analysis through the use of parametrics and other data-driven techniques by:

- Fostering the professional growth of its members within the allied fields of estimating and analysis.
- Enhancing the understanding and appreciation of using data-driven estimating and analysis techniques throughout allied fields and the general population.
- Providing educational opportunities to practitioners in cost and parametric estimating and analysis, as well as with allied fields.
- Establishing standards in terminology, conduct, and application of estimating and analysis techniques.

Purpose of ICEAA (continued)

- Developing the means to achieve and measure established standards.
- Recognizing achievement through an appropriate program of recognition and certification.
- Providing forums and media through which experiences with all of the principles and techniques associated with data-driven cost estimating and analysis may be reported, discussed, and published in furtherance of the public interest.
- Fostering, promoting, and conducting research in all estimating and analysis techniques.
- Developing and maintaining standards of proficiency and ethics.
- Cooperating with other national and international organizations and individuals, having common or related purposes, in furtherance of the public interest.

Chapter Level Opportunities

- Help is ALWAYS appreciated at the chapter level and many opportunities for emerging leaders
- Chapter level board positions (president, vice president, etc.)
- Planning get togethers, lunch & learns, virtual meetings
- Recruiting new ICEAA members (MOST IMPORTANT)
- Setting up trainings/certification study sessions

Workshop Opportunities

- **Abstract Review Chair/Co-Chair**
 - Coordinates Abstract Review teams, provides final guidance on scoring
- **Abstract/Presentation Reviewers (as many as possible)**
 - Read 10-20 presentation abstracts, score on applicability, complexity, etc.
 - After draft presentations due, provide peer feedback to 2-4 authors on their presentations
- **Best Paper Chair/Co-Chair**
 - Coordinates Best Paper Judge teams, provides final guidance on scoring
- **Best Paper Judges (~20 – 40)**
 - Read and score 6-8 narrative whitepapers in round one to select best in track winners
 - Read and score 6-8 narrative whitepapers in round two to select best overall winner

Workshop Opportunities

- Association Awards Chair/Co-Chair
 - Coordinates Awards Judges, provides final guidance on scoring
- Awards Judges Reviewers (~12 – 30)
 - Read and score association awards nominations
- Track Chairs (20+)
 - Introduce breakout session speakers, monitor room for AV issues or other problems, keep speakers on time/schedule, provide attendee head counts
- Training Track instructors (~12 – 20)
 - Instruct CEBoK modules, answer questions, walk through practice exercises with attendees
- Keynote outreach (as many as possible)
 - Leverage your network and contacts to help secure keynote speakers, panelists, moderators, etc.

International Committees and Perennial Opportunities

- Strategic Planning committee always looking for new ideas/members
 - Meets 6-8x per year
- Board nominating committee (every 2 years, ~6 volunteers)
- *Journal of Cost Analysis and Parametrics* peer reviewers, editors
 - Three issues per year, 6-8 articles per issue
- CCEA/PCEA exam questions
 - Proposed new questions (with answers) based on CEBoK to add to the question bank, questions that are accepted will be featured on future tests

International Board Positions

- **Executive Committee:** President, Executive Vice President, Vice President for Professional Development, Secretary, Treasurer
 - Attend all Board of Directors meetings, participate in additional meetings/calls, perform additional duties. 80 hours/year commitment
- **Region Directors 1-7, International Region Directors, two At-Large Directors**
 - All are expected to attend the all annual board meetings and additional duties as required or desired. 40-60 hours/year commitment
