Certification Summary

- Overall certifications as of July 2022:
 - CCEA[®] **761** (including 11 CCEA[®]-P [↓] 10 since April 22, 2022)
 - PCEA® 120 (including 30 CCEA Eligible 3 since April 22, 2022)
 - CPP **9** (no change)
- Re-certifications:
 - 42 certifications have renewed in 2022
 - 76 total in 2021, 81 in 2020, 86 in 2019, 97 in 2018, 80 in 2017
- Other Countries with Certified Individuals:
 - UK 51
 - Canada 59
 - Australia 5
 - Brussels 4
 - Saudi Arabia & Egypt 2

Certification Program ...

- Operational Status
 69 Exam Administered between in 2022 through July 2022
 - 156 in 2021
 148 in 2020
 215 in 2019
 167 in 2018
 164 in 2017
 - Of the 69 Exams:
 50 Industry
 19 Government (US Coast Guard, DHS, NAVAIR, Air Force)
 - 43 exams are scheduled

Recertification is EASY as Pi

30 points is required for continued certification without taking the test

Multiple opportunities to accumulate points during the 5 year period:

- Stay in the cost field! -3 pts/yr
- ICEAA/other cost-related Memberships 1 point per year
- Attend cost estimating-related conferences 2 points per multi-day conference
- Leadership roles in cost estimating-related organizations 3 points per year per role
- Committee/working group service to cost estimating-related events or publications 1
 point per committee role per event/publication
- Recognition for contributions to cost estimating-related organizations 1 3 points per award
- Completing university/college course(s) in cost estimating-related topics (with a final grade of C or higher) 3 points per 3-credit (or full-semester) course
- Attending association/industry trainings 0.1 point per classroom hour
- Teaching, lecturing, presenting on cost estimating-related topics 1 point per 90 mins / 2
 pts over 90 mins
- Writing, publishing non-refereed articles on cost estimating-related topics 3 points per published article
- Writing, publishing refereed "technical" articles on cost estimating-related topics 5
 points per refereed article
- Submit up to ten questions for each certification exam part 1 point per approved question (contact ICEAA for specific guidelines)

CEBoK

- CEBoK 2.0 is available for all ICEAA members via our website
- All CCEA/PCEA test questions are derived from the materials in CEBoK 2.0
- Enterprise Access:
 - For those organizations requiring access to CEBoK®2.0 for a large number of individuals but are unable to purchase ICEAA memberships for each user, ICEAA is offering CEBoK®2.0 Enterprise Access:
 - 25-49 users: \$5,000 per year 50-99 users: \$7,500 per year 100+ users: \$10,000 per year

CEBoK

- Electronic Copies of PPT and Excel files
 - Individual copies of the previous version of CEBoK® (version1.2) are still available for purchase.
 - CEBoK®1.2 is a collection of PowerPoint, Excel, and PDF files on USB thumb drives for \$235 for ICEAA members and \$335 for non-members.
 - Shipping is included in the purchase price.
 - For those unable to use USB thumb drives, you may request to have a copy of CEBoK®1.2 burned onto a CD for an additional fee of \$25 per copy.

CEBoK-S

- Will be releasing CEBoK-S this fall
 - Initial release is PPT with notes only
 - Will be available for purchase on ICEAA website
- We are in the process of building the Software Estimating Certification exam
 - We need questions submitted
 - We currently have 50 of the necessary 75 required to build an effective exam

Online Training

- In process of implementing a new system that will provide on-demand purchase/viewing of training videos
 - Special pricing for members
 - Will be adding additional content on a regular basis
 - Can be used for certification points




2022 Financial Outlook

- Overall, set to finish 2022 in a stronger than expected financial position
 - In person 2022 workshop was a success
 - Higher than expected registration helped avoid room attrition fees and secure revenue
 - Canada workshop canceled
 - Giving out chapter funding for the first time since COVID
 - Operations costs continued as normal
 - Paid bill for a new Learning Management System
 - Upcoming dues increase will help total liquidity

Balance Sheet 2014-2022


